Review the Information provided in the Reference Material section of the Logbook

## Review the Information within each tab section:

- 1. The tabbed monthly sections January-May and October-December are identical; they include daily, weekly and monthly requirements for the systems and components.
- 2. The tabbed monthly sections June-September are identical: they include weekly and monthly requirements for the systems and components.
- 3. The tabbed Quarterly, Semi-Annual, Annual and Multi-Year sections include the respective requirements for the systems and components at the tabbed frequency.
- 4. The heading of each page within each tabbed section identifies the system, the task (Inspection, Test or Maintenance), and the frequency. Below that the forms identify the components and provide information on performing the task.
- 5. Any systems/component/component frequency (non-supervised/supervised) in any of the tabbed sections that are not applicable to your buildings systems/component/component frequency (non-supervised/supervised), *the form or respective section of the form should be marked "N/A"*.
- 6. The Impairment tabbed section includes the "IMPAIRMENT REPORT" as well as reference information for fire protection systems and alarm systems being placed out of service. This tabbed section also includes the reference information for fire guard/fire watch and the "FIRE GUARD/FIRE WATCH DAILY INSPECTION REPORT".
- 7. The Additional Information tabbed section includes information regarding the B-29 Certificate of Fitness for Supervision of Battery Systems and Other Related Equipment and a sample form for the required inspections.
